Our campus covers over 70,000 square meters and hosts a range of custom-built, state-of-the-art facilities that provide pupils with access to the very best academic and co-curricular opportunities. We work closely and collaboratively with the Wellington College China group schools and Wellington College International in the UK, where there are regular meetings for collaboration among staff and annual reviews conducted by members of the Wellington College International team. Our bilingual schools take the name 'Hiba Academy Hangzhou' (formerly 'Huili') and our international schools are named 'Wellington College International Hangzhou'. All schools belong to the Wellington College China family.

Each A Level subject is taught six times per week, each lesson lasts 55 minutes. The English support lessons are taught 3 to 5 times per week, depending on the pupil. At A Level class sizes are small, rarely exceeding 16. Pupils are encouraged to choose A Level subjects based on their own interests. Each pupil meets with university guidance counsellors to discuss suitable subjects given their career aspirations. In addition, we offer around 100 school activities for our pupils to study, here are some examples of our school activities we offered.

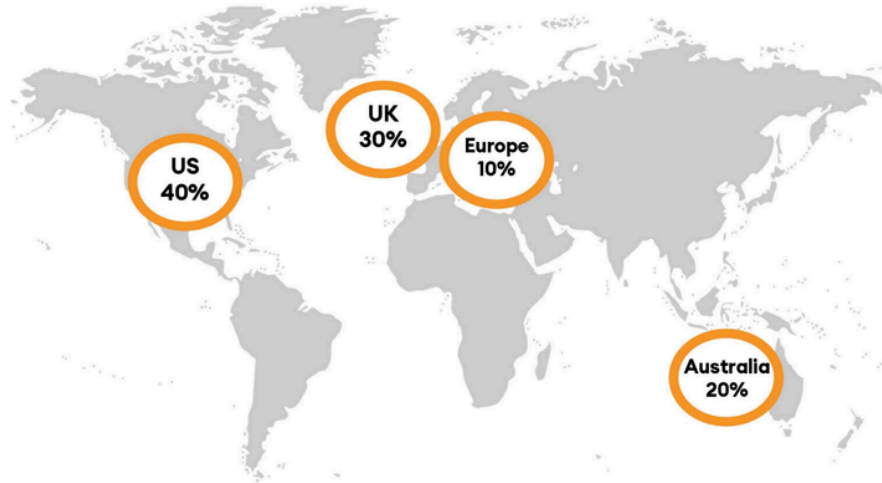
