Secondary English teacher

The Huili Secondary English programme is designed to engage students in English language and literature and to develop, not only the knowledge and skills of students, but also to build more independent learners across the wider curriculum. In junior high (grades 6-8), we have built a tailor-made curriculum for our pupils to ensure language development and an understanding of literature, while fostering a love of English language learning. We do this by engaging students in a variety of texts that include fiction, non-fiction and poetry in each grade. In our bourgeoning high school, the vast majority of our students study IGCSE English as a First Language and English Literature. The two-year IGCSE course enables students to better prepare for the IBDP programme. We also ensure that, for both IGCSE and IBDP, we offer CPD to help develop further develop our teachers.

As well as preparing for IGCSE and IBDP, the English department also offer a wide range of extracurricular activities for the students where English language lies at the centre. These primarily centre around different forms of debate and we see it as an opportunity to further enhance our students' experience at Huili.

The Huili English department's purpose is to not only develop the language and understanding of our pupils but to better prepare them from a world beyond Huili. We believe through English different cultures can be presented from different perspectives broadening the minds of our students. As a bilingual school, we understand the importance that both language and culture play in our students' future.

Secondary Economics teacher

The Social Studies Department at Huili consists of a variety of subjects. At IGCSE, students have the option of taking history, geography, global perspectives, or economics, with the majority of students choosing multiple courses due to the success of the department and Huili students' eagerness to study the humanities. The curriculum in Junior High School (KS3) is unique, with students studying both the national curriculum in history and geography, and a specially designed course 'English Social Studies' in which Huili students extend their knowledge of key areas of history, physical and cultural geography, and economics, all while building the skills necessary for success at IGCSE and IBDP. This helps them bridge the gap between the national curriculum and the international courses they take in high school.

One of the key focuses of the department is to support students in developing 21st century skills, including research, critical thinking, teamwork, communication, and reflection. Observers of lessons in the department may see students passionately participating in team debates, evaluating potential courses of action to global problems, or reflecting on how their life experiences have influenced their views and how they might empathise with others who have different perspectives. Although one of the goals of the department is to produce excellent IGCSE and IBDP results, at the same time, we look to build in students the skills necessary to be successful long after they leave Huili. The department is looking for a professional and enthusiastic educator to teach IGCSE Economics and eventually IBDP Economics. A candidate with experience in both Economics as well as other areas of the social sciences is preferred. Additionally, the department is looking for a collaborator who is both flexible and adaptable in their teaching approach and has skills in co-planning as well as experience with teaching bilingual students or students with EAL needs.

Secondary PE teacher

As part of the PE curriculum, we offer a comprehensive aquatics programme across all age groups. With the addition of older year groups, we plan to offer IGCSE PE and IB Sports Science in the near future. Our aim is for students of all ages to have opportunities to participate in numerous sports teams and in a wide range of local, regional, and international events. The successful applicant will be expected to be highly involved in our extensive extra-curricular (CCAs) clubs and lead sports teams and events in their specialist areas.

Secondary Science teacher

The science department at Huili School Shanghai aims to ensure that all pupils develop a natural curiosity for the world around them by providing an outstanding learning environment in which every student can succeed.

Science at Huili School Shanghai comprises of natural science, biology, chemistry and physics. Lessons are supported by state-of-the-art equipment and are taught in specialised laboratories for each subject. Science starts in grade one and is taught during weekly natural science classes. Primary and secondary teachers work collaboratively to ensure an engaging and cohesive curriculum. In Junior High, students are taught a range of topics that blend the three main disciplines within the framework of both the UK and Chinese curriculum. There is a strong emphasis on investigative work to ensure that students are independent critical thinkers. At IGCSE, all students study chemistry and at least one other science from physics and biology; there is also the option to study all three single sciences.



At IBDP, students will have the option to pursue biology, chemistry, or physics at higher and standard level.

Performing arts teacher (primary and secondary)

The Huili Arts department is comprised of visual arts, design technology, music, performing arts, drama and dance. Our excellent facilities include a state of the art professional-standard theatre, a black box studio, recording studio, two dance studios, art and design classrooms, music practice rooms and bespoke teaching spaces.

The arts programme offers plentiful opportunities for students to showcase their artistry, whether it is in the classroom, in formal concerts, house competitions, assembly performances, lunchtime recitals or full-scale theatre productions . In primary, teachers blend the best of the east with the best of the west in a bespoke curriculum that prepares students for progression. In junior high, students undergo a foundation skills-based arts curriculum that prepares them for IGCSE studies in Music, Drama or Art & Design. We are anticipating a strong take-up of Arts subjects as part of the IBDP programme once our students progress beyond IGCSE.

The Huili Arts department's purpose is to facilitate engagement in quality arts experiences. We believe that the arts allow for an expression of self and of culture. As a school, we hold the arts as an essential human experience. We have excellent relationships with artists, musicians and arts practitioners both here in Shanghai and internationally.

Secondary Spanish teacher

In Junior High (KS3), all students study Spanish as a third language. Progress is rapid with students enjoying language learning and appreciating the value of learning multiple languages. Currently, there is one IGCSE class in Grade 9 and we expect to have the same next year. We also expect to be able to offer IBDP Spanish in grades 11 and 12. We are looking for an enthusiastic practitioner who is passionate about language and able to teach to at least IGCSE level. Experience of IBDP and/or A-Level would also be an advantage.

Secondary ICT/Computer Science teacher

In Junior High (KS3) all students have ICT lessons based on a bespoke curriculum developed to meet the needs of Huili students. Students enjoy learning about ICT, computing, programming and online safety. This year, IGCSE Computer Science was introduced and proved to be a popular option, with excellent results expected from our very able students. In grades 11 and 12, we hope to offer IBDP Computer Science and we have a number of students who are passionate about further study within the field. We are looking for an excellent practitioner who is able to teach ICT and Computer Science at IGCSE and IBDP and/or A-Level.
