Each A Level subject is taught six times per week, and each lesson lasts 55 minutes. The English support lessons are taught 3 to 5 times per week, depending on the pupil. At A Level, class sizes are small, rarely exceeding 16. Pupils are encouraged to choose A Level subjects based on their own interests. Each pupil meets with university guidance counsellors to discuss suitable subjects given their career aspirations. In addition, we offer around 100 school activities for our pupils to study. 


